
Dear Mr. Spooner:

Your letter of January 29th addressed to the Superintendent has been referred to us for reply.

On July 26, 1949 Governor G. Mennen Williams signed papers granting Meda commutation of sentence from Life to 26 years, 7 months and 23 days and on August 7, 1949 she was released at the expiration of her sentence.

We understand that she went to work as a housekeeper in the home of a Catholic Priest in Detroit. She telephoned the institution several times and always seemed quite happy and contented in her new life. We do not have the date but sometime later we heard that she had died quite suddenly.
